Chopped Sirloin \$13.50

Lean ground sirloin, grilled and smothered in our home made gravy and topped with sautéed mushrooms.

Liver and Onions \$13.50

Top grade beef liver, dusted in flour and grilled with sautéed onions and bacon.

BBQ Pork Chops \$13.50

A 10oz porterhouse chops basted with our house barbeque sauce. Traditional BBQ at its best.

English Style Fish \$13.50

Captain James Wynard Steinhoff was perhaps Wallaceburg's most influential citizen. While almost singlehandedly setting the community on the path of industrialization, Steinhoff was also a prominent figure in the politics and community life of the town, becoming Wallaceburg's first mayor in 1896.

Steinhoff was an amazing example of the new province's opportunity and growth. At the age of 10 he delivered mail aboard a pony through 25 miles of heavy forest. He later became a cook for a French lumber mill. While loading cords of wood aboard early clipper ships, Steinhoff dreamed of steam powered vessels, and at the age of 20 began his shipbuilding career, by producing large steam powered tugs. His most famous was the "Dominion" launched on Confederation Day, 1867.

Capt. Steinhoff retired from the shipping business in 1887 a wealthy man. However, his influence, and financial backing, continued to drive Wallaceburg into the industrial age. He owned a bank and with his nephew David Alexander Gordon was a powerful Stockholder in many local industries, including Wallaceburg Cooperage Company, Sydenham Glass Company and the Canada and Dominion Sugar Company. Captain Steinhoff died in 1921 at the age of 87.

Beef Steak Portabella \$13.50

Steak strips grilled with portabella mushrooms, onions, peppers and asparagus served tossed with penne noodles in our house brown.

Chicken Bella \$13.50

A breast of chicken topped with sautéed baby portabella mushrooms and our creamy Parmesan sauce.

BBQ Chicken Breast \$13.50

A simple, yet tasty favorite, using a boneless breast of chicken, char broiled in our house BBQ sauce
